SEWING:

1. Article of Embroidery
2. Hanky with crochet edge
3. Article featuring EPP (English Paper Piecing) eg:hexagons
4. Counted Cross Stitch, must be framed, no smaller than 25cm x 25cm. (not painted or stamped)
5. Article of Framed Needlework
6. Bag made using patchwork
7. Article made using up to 1 metre of material.
8. Sewn article suitable for home use. (eg, potholder, apron, tea towel)
9. Small gift featuring embroidery. (eg, coat hanger, lav bag, hand towel)
10. Best sewn soft toy or doll, must be playable.
11. Patchwork quilt.
12. Any other patchwork article
13. Sewn bag, not patchwork
14. Best made cushion (not patchwork).
15. Article featuring hand appliqué.
16. Article featuring machine appliqué.
17. Machine made article of clothing.
18. Sewn Article by person **over** 70 years.
19. Sewing Aide / companion –eg pincushion, needlecase, pouch
20. Sewn dolls clothes – doll not to be judged
21. Article featuring tapestry or Long Stitch

KNITTING and CROCHET.

22. Crochet doily, no bigger than 30cm diameter
23. Piece of fine crochet (not doily) by person **over** 70yr.
24. Piece of fine crochet (not doily) by person **under** 70yr.
25. Knitted or crochet small wearable accessory-not fancy yarn (eg; hat, scarf, gloves, socks).
26. Knitted or crochet article made in fancy yarn (feathers, loopy, ostrich etc)
27. Child's Hand Knitted Article 8 ply or over.
28. Baby's Knitted Dress or Jacket.
29. Baby's Crocheted Dress or Jacket.

30. One pair Knitted Bootees.
31. One pair Crocheted Bootees.
32. Child's Hand Knitted Article, basques and cuffs optional, 5 ply wool and under.
33. Lady's or Man's Hand Knitted Jumper, Cardigan or Vest.
34. Knitted or crochet Toy, must be playable.
35. Hand Knitted or Crocheted baby rug up to cot size.
36. Hand Knitted or Crocheted knee rug (1 metre x 1 metre)
37. Hand Knitted or Crochet rug, larger than knee rug.
39. One Skein of Hand Spun Wool.
40. Article Made from Hand Spun Wool.
41. Hand Knitted or Crochet adult shawl.
42. Hand Knitted or Crochet baby shawl, 5 ply and under.
43. Knitted or Crocheted Coat Hanger.
44. Hand Knitted Apparel, 8 ply or over, Rosemary Elworthy Memorial Trophy.
45. Article from Mohair or Mohair Blend, must contain at least 50% Mohair, label attached.
46. Knitted or Crocheted Tea Cosy.
47. Any other article not mentioned.
48. Knitted or crochet set of dolls clothes
49. Article featuring felted wool work.
50. Article of knitting or crochet by person **over** 70 yrs, (not fine crochet)
